

Confidentiality of students' information


- Students are encouraged to notify relevant offices of their special needs

Number of Students with Self-declared Disabilities in CUHK




*Figure of 2014-15 is as of end of February 2015; other figures are as of end of July.

Students with Disabilities 2014-2015




Distribution by Nature of Disability (Physical vs Non-Physical)

Students with Physical Disabilities (n= 33)




Distribution by Type of Disability

Students with Non-Physical Disabilities (n=32)




Distribution by Type of Disability

 - career guidance


Office of Student Affairs -

Coordinating Disability Support Services

- Act as central point of contact and coordinator of services since 2012-13
- Collect information/documentation on students' disabilities & special needs
- Assess the specific needs of individual students in learning & daily living at the University
- Make recommendations on support services for individual students
- Coordinate with relevant units on the provision of special support services for individual students
- Maintain & update database on disabled students
- Raise disability awareness in the University

Challenges Encountered in Supporting Students with Disabilities

- Increasing student number and diversity of disabilities
 - 2013-14: a student with multiple disabilities
 - 2014-15: 2 students with hearing impairment using sign languages for communication
- Logistic and manpower support
 - Limited availability of certain equipment in some parts of the campus
 - Some support services, such as conversion of course materials and electronic text production, require a large amount of manpower support
- Professional support
 - As students' disabilities become more diversified, there is increasing demand for professional support, such as sign language interpretation and professional consultation
- Disability awareness among campus community
 - The overall disability awareness has yet to be enhanced
