### Developments in Recent Years

Heightened community awareness & Government's efforts to ensure equal opportunities

- Disability Discrimination Ordinance
- Code of Practice on Education

Improved learning environments & enhanced support in early, primary and secondary education

- More students with disabilities & special educational needs can be admitted into tertiary institutions

Expansion in student exchange programmes in tertiary institutions

- Increase in number of non-local students with disabilities & special needs for support

Increase in demand for support services
